**PETITIONER WILLIAM FERGUSON’S  
APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE BRIEF**

Pursuant to Pennsylvania Rules of Appellate Procedure 123(a) and 3714(c), Petitioner William Ferguson respectfully submits this Application for Extension of Time to File Brief. In support thereof, Petitioner avers the following:

1. This proceeding involves an appeal by Petitioner of an Order of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) that dismissed his complaint challenging an annual expense claim of \$1,200,000 made by Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. (“Aqua”) in its 2021 general rate case that ceased to exist during the rate case proceeding but was not withdrawn by Aqua when no party challenged it, resulting in \$1,200,000 of unjustified annual charges being assigned in the Commission’s final rate case order solely to Aqua’s New Garden Township, Chester County, wastewater customers.

2. On August 29, 2025, this Court’s Filing Office notified the parties to this appeal that, pursuant to Pa.R.A.P. 2185(a), Petitioner’s brief and the reproduced record are due on October 8, 2025.

3. On August 20, 2025, counsel for Petitioner contacted counsel for the Commission and counsel for Aqua and informed them that he intended to seek a 30-day extension to file Petitioner's brief and the reproduced record because Petitioner's counsel was unavoidably away for most of the month of September because of family obligations, which would prevent adequate time for the preparation of Petitioner's brief and the reproduced record.

4. Counsel for the Commission and counsel for Aqua replied that neither party opposes this request.

5. This is Petitioner's first request for an extension in this appeal.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court issue an Order granting Petitioner's first Application for Extension of Time to File Brief, allowing him an additional thirty (30) days, i.e., on or before November 7, 2025, for filing of his brief and the reproduced record. A proposed form of Order is attached.
